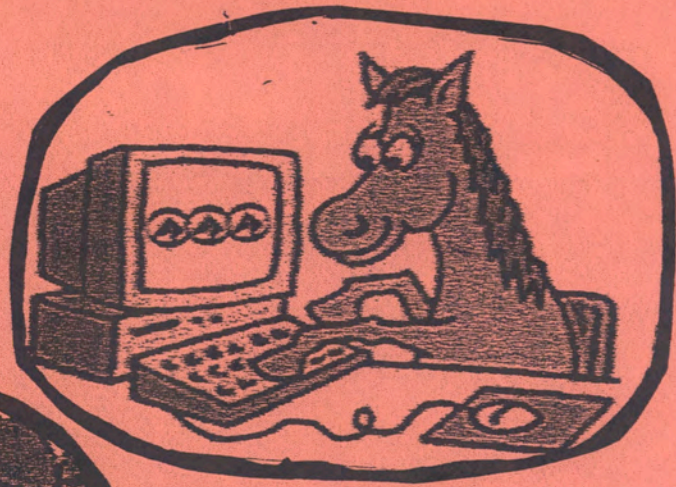

It's Horse Camp Time.....

June 10 - 12 Deadline June 1st
August 26-28 Deadline August 15th

Camp will be from **Friday 4pm To Sunday at 4pm.**

The cost is \$175. We require no downpayment with your registration however PLEASE get us **the form no later than June 1st and August 15th.** Activities such as bareback riding, riding in the cart (buggy), horse games, lunging horses, bathing and preparing horses for shows, the list goes on!

Overnight Campers: Evening activities include bonfires, roasting marshmallows, watching horse movies and watching a video of that day's lesson. Staying overnight is optional, Campers can go home if they wish and return the next morning, there is no price difference. We encourage them to be back early in the morning for doing barn chores, feeding and mucking out stalls.

A campers checklist is attached. Please don't forget anything. Make sure all of your belongings are marked with your name. We have riding equipment available such as helmets, boots & jodphurs (riding pants)

If you need transportation to get here on Friday please let us know. We can help out with that.

RELEASE FROM LIABILITY CONTRACT

The release of LIABILITY is made & entered into on _____ DATE _____, by & between Rancho Del Rio & its assigns, hereinafter designated STABLE &

RIDER _____

hereinafter designated RIDER, &, if rider is a minor, RIDER'S parent or guardian, _____

RIDER'S PARENT/GUARDIAN

IT IS HEREBY AGREED TO AS FOLLOWS:

1. That RIDER, the undersigned, do for myself or on behalf of my child or legal ward, hereby voluntarily request to participate in riding instruction as a student at STABLE, & that student will either ride his or her own horse, or school horses provided by STABLE for instructional purposes.
2. That parent or guardian and student understand that horses are unpredictable by nature, that when frightened or angry or under stress, a horse's natural instincts are to jump forward or sideways, to run away from danger at a trot or gallop, to kick, to buck, to rear up in front, or to bit; that horses are extremely powerful; and that if a rider falls to the ground, the fall distance will be generally from 3 1/2 feet assume these risks & dangers.
3. That it is the responsibility of the RIDER to carry full & complete coverage on his horse, personal property & himself.
4. That RIDER has been advised that students should purchase & wear a helmet & to wear it around the stable so as to prevent horse related injuries.
5. That RIDER agrees to assume any & all risks involved in or arising from instruction by STABLE or use of STABLE'S property or services, including but not limited to, the risks of death, bodily injury, property damage, falls, kicks, bites, collisions with vehicles, horses or stationary objects, or the negligence or deliberate act of another person.
6. That RIDER agrees to hold STABLE and all of its successors, assigns and agents completely harmless & not liable & release them from all liability whatsoever and agrees not to sue them on account of or in connection with any claims, causes of action, injuries, damages, or costs or expenses arising out of RIDER'S use of STABLE'S property or services or from instruction by STABLE.
7. That RIDER agrees to abide by all stable or instructor's rules & regulations, including but not limited to the constant use of protective headgear, shoes or boots with 1 inch heels (minimum) and hard soles.
8. That if RIDER is using his horse, the horse shall be free from infection, contagious or transmissible disease.

RIDER or RIDER'S parent or guardian has read and understands all terms as explained above.

HELMET WAIVER

It is statistically clear that there are certain inherent dangers associated with horseback riding. One of those dangers associated with horseback riding. One of those dangers is the risk of suffering serious head injuries should the rider fall or be thrown from his/her horse. It is therefore the policy of Rancho Del Rio & its assigns, that safety riding helmets will be worn at all times when riders are mounted on a horse.

I, _____, being fully aware of that policy and the reasons for it, choose, of my own free will, not to wear a safety riding helmet. In taking this action, I hold Rancho Del Rio, its assigns, and their insurer free of any and all liabilities for injuries that I may receive as a result of my actions and failure to wear a safety riding helmet.
